No wait, Low-Cost Lessons

- (a) In order to avoid the 1-year waiting list, I agree to waive the 16 weeks of *free* lessons.
- (b) I choose to pay full price (\$150 for each 8-weeks of lessons) for my child to be enrolled in the next available class.

Up to 1-year wait, Free Lesson (Depending on Instrument)

- (c) I choose to remain on the waiting list in order for my child to receive the 1st 16-weeks of lessons free.
- (d) All applicants are chosen on a first-come, first-served basis and contacted by telephone. In exchange for the free lessons, parent(s) shall either:
 - Volunteer a minimum of 10-hrs during each 8-week session (with a \$75 refundable deposit)
 - Pre-pay and sell \$160 worth of donation drawing tickets.
- (e) After the 1st 16-weeks of free lessons, I agree to either pre-pay and sell \$160 worth of donation drawing tickets or make a payment of \$150 for each additional 8-weeks of lessons.

Music Lesson Policies

- All students are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful manner. Unruly behavior impacts the educational experience for all students; therefore, the Fender Center reserves the right to refuse to provide instruction to any child that does not adhere to this policy. The child will receive one verbal warning for a first offense. Second offense will result in dismissal from class and the child will then be sent to the office (& considered absent), where a phone calls home will be made.
- Attendance at each class session is critical. Students who miss more than **one class in a session will be dropped from the class**. Students who come to class without course materials (un-prepared) will not be allowed to stay in class and will be considered automatically absent. Advance notification is recommended if it is known that the child will miss a class.
- The Fender Center may provide the first 16 weeks of music lessons with no fee to the student. These costs are covered by the generosity of donations to the Fender Center. In turn, parent(s) shall either volunteer a minimum of 10 hours during each eight weeks of lessons (with a \$75 refundable/rollover deposit) or pre-pay and sell \$160 worth of tickets for a donation drawing. In the event that you need to reschedule your volunteer hours, you may be given one (1) opportunity to reschedule and make-up the hours. However, in order to be given this opportunity, you must notify staff 48-hours prior to your scheduled volunteer time and arrange for the make-up hours. *Failure to provide this notice, arrange for the make-up hours, and/or complete all 10-hours you committed to, will result in an automatic non-refundable deposit and no attempt by staff will be made to reschedule or schedule additional hours to meet your 10-hour commitment. Children are not permitted to accompany parent(s) while volunteering. All volunteers must be at least 16 years of age. Students who complete the beginning lessons at the Fender Center will be given priority in placement for future intermediate or advanced classes. For each additional 8-week session after the first 2 sessions, parent(s) shall either pre-pay and sell \$160 worth of tickets for a donation drawing or make a payment of \$150. Parents who do not meet registration deadlines to re-enroll their child for each session will automatically be dropped from the program or be subject to a \$75 re-enrollment fee, in addition to the \$150 payment for lessons.
- Refund Policy: All payments are final. No refunds, No exceptions regardless of unforeseen circumstances or changes to class schedules.
- No waiting will be allowed in hallways, stairways, or inside the class rooms.
- On occasion, photos/film/recording of students may be taken during their classes and at special events. These photos/film/recordings may be used free of charge in promotional materials for the Fender Center or its programs.
- To ensure your child's safety, please be sure to pick him/her up promptly after class. Children waiting at the Fender Center before and/or after their class are NOT supervised. Children are under supervision during their instruction time only. Neither teachers nor administrative staff is responsible for supervising children outside of teaching time.
- I hereby authorize the Fender Center to send me reminders about the Kids Rock Free® program, upcoming events and other Fender news via email. I understand that the Fender Center will not share my email address with any other persons or agencies without my consent. This authorization will remain in effect until I revoke this authorization by unsubscribing online at www.fendercenter.org.
- Realizing that accidents may happen, parents will agree to the following provisions:

In case of an emergency requiring medical treatment for my child while attending a music lesson at the Fender Center, I authorize any licensed physician, nurse, or hospital to render such treatment to my child as they deem necessary. I consent to treatment and to pay any and all costs incurred as a result of said treatment.

Furthermore, I absolve and hold harmless the Fender Center its Officers, employees and volunteers from all liabilities or claims or damages to myself, or the minor person registered to participate for whom I have legal responsibility, resulting from or arising out of participation in Center-sponsored activities.

By affixing my signature below, I pledge that I have legal responsibility for the minor child enrolled in music lessons at the Fender Center. I also acknowledge that I have read and understand the Music Lessons Policies and I agree to adhere to them.
